The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Lisa Diernisse

Board Members present at the meeting were: Lisa Diernisse, Errol Bergsagel, Diane Struck, Keith Kerr and Mary Ellen Hook. Visitor Linda Kristoff was also in attendance to report on the status of the Old Mill Road Speed Study.

Moved and seconded that the January minutes be approved as submitted. Unanimous vote to approve.

New Business

- Lisa reported that the community yard sale is scheduled for Saturday, May 6. Advertising for the yard sale will be in the Patch and Mount Vernon Voice newspapers and on Craig's List. Mount Zephyr and the Mount Vernon Methodist Church will have yard sales on the same day and will advertise in their newsletter. The MVMCA membership drive begins on April 1. Membership applications are ready to distribute to mailboxes. The block captain situation is not very good; maybe if we rename them "Distribution Volunteers", there would be more interest.
- Diane noted that the dead end sign has been replaced on McNair Drive. She asked again about the trash can in the park at the end of McNair. James Perkins will need to address this concern. The community holiday party can be moved from the first Thursday to the first Wednesday in December.
- Mary Ellen provided the information to donate funds for the Mount Vernon High School All Night Graduation Party.
- Keith mentioned that since Frank Cohn moved to Lee District, there is no representative to the MVCCA for our area. Keith does not want to take this position. James Perkins will take on the MVCCA Liaison position.
- Linda Kristoff is still working on bike trails in Fairfax County. Keith noted that there is a bike master plan which included the Sherwood Hall Road repaving and marking to enhance bike lanes. Mount Vernon needs to advocate for bike safety. Concerning the Old Mill plan: one gentleman refused to agree to a speed bump in front of his home and VDOT moved it down a few yards. They are knocking on people's doors and need four more approvals from homeowners then more community approval will be required.
